Boshkoff resigns law school post

President John W. Ryan today announced he has accepted with regret the resignation of Douglass G. Boshkoff as dean of the Indiana University School of Law, Bloomington, effective Jan. 15, 1976.

Dean Boshkoff will resume teaching following a sabbatical leave which was approved last month by the trustees of Indiana University for the second semester of the 1975-76 academic year.

"We have been fortunate to have a person of Douglass Boshkoff's talent and dedication serving as dean of the IU Law School," President Ryan stated. "His many outstanding achievements have contributed much to the success of our academic program and have enhanced the reputation of the University.

"Although he is stepping out of his role as an administrator, it is gratifying to know that IU will continue to be able to draw upon his considerable abilities and experience as a teacher. I have been particularly appreciative of Dean Boshkoff's personal friendship and his contributions and help to me with general university problems in the years of my presidency and his deanship."

Boshkoff explained his original plan was to serve as dean for approximately five

years. "Since that period will end next summer and I plan to be on sabbatical during the spring semester, it seems now is the time to initiate plans to turn the job over to someone else," he said.

He was named acting dean in 1971 and became dean of the Law School in 1972.

Boshkoff joined the IU faculty in 1962 as visiting associate professor of law. In 1965, he became professor of law and that same year was voted outstanding professor of law and that same year was voted outstanding professor by School of Law students.
