Mrs. Hugh Willis Dies In Hospital

Mrs. Esther (DeCoster) Willis, 80, of 836 Sheridan Drive, died at 6:45 p.m. Thursday in Bloomington Hospital. She had been in ill health several years and recently underwent surgery.

She was the wife of Hugh E. Willis, retired professor of law at Indiana University. He taught there from 1922 to 1948. Her husband is the only immediate survivor.

Mrs. Willis was born in Minnesota and graduated from the University of Minnesota. She belonged to the Presbyterian Church, Alpha Phi sorority, the 19th Century Club, the Women's Club and the Faculty Women's Club.

Funeral services are planned at 3 p.m. Saturday in the Day Chapel with Rev. W. Douglas Rae officiating. Burial will be in Rose Hill Cemetery.
