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# MISS JESSIE HOGATE STUDYING IN LONDON

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**Writes Parents That She Escaped  
German Bombardment of Scar-  
borough by Few Days.**

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**WAS VISITING FRIENDS THERE**

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Miss Jessie Hogate writes from London to her father, Judge Enoch Hogate, that she is having a delightful and profitable experience and has no intention of returning home immediately. Miss Hogate left last summer two days before war was declared for a year's study in Europe. Her parents wished her to come home after the war commenced, but she says there is little more danger in England than in America now, and will finish her study there.

Until the Christmas holidays she was attending lectures on Mediaeval History in the British Museum. She is now enrolled in the University of London. She lives at a hotel in the center of the city where several officers in the British army are staying with their families, and here she often sees the soldiers as they start for the front and when they come back wounded.

She was visiting with friends at Scarborough, and left just a few days before the bombardment by the German warships.

Miss Hogate was ill in an Edinburgh hospital for some time last fall, and she has the highest praise for the Scotch people. When they learned she was an American they gave her the best of care and treatment. She has joined the American Relief Society in London which makes warm clothes for the soldiers and sends them to the front.
