Gavel Award Is Made To Harvey

William B. Harvey, professor of law and professor of political science at Indiana University Bloomington, was given the Gavel Award at the recent Law Day ceremony here.

The Gavel Award is given to that member of the School of Law faculty or staff whom the seniors believe has done most for them during their three years in law school.

According to Mike Huston,
Student Bar Association, Harvey's award was due, in part,
to his efforts to improve the
quality of the legal education
offered IU students here and
in upgrading the school. Harvey, who is on leave of
absence, resigned last year as
dean of the School of Law.

The president's award, which is given by the SBA president to a student who has been of great assistance to the president, went to Tom Clancy of Michigan City.

Clancy, Huston said, organized the Law Day dinners at which law faculty entertained students in their homes. Clancy also organized the Law School football block and took care of ticket arrangements for some 250 law students. He is also chairman of the Student Bar Relations Committee, which was formed this year.
