IU Receives New Law Scholarship

BLOOMINGTON, Nov. 25—

Indiana University's first law school dean, who was so determined to pursue a legal education that he walked all the way from Iowa to the Hoosier state, will be memorialized by a new scholarship fund.

The David D. Banta Award has been established by George Banta Jr., chairman of the board of George Banta Publishing Co., Menasha, Wis., and grandson of the late dean. Law School Dean Leon H. Wallace said income from the \$5000 grant will be used to present an annual award to a full-time law student chosen by the Law School faculty.
