### NEWS FROM THE FACULTY

**Professor Hannah Buxbaum** presented a paper entitled "The Privilege Against Self-Incrimination and Cross-Border Regulatory Enforcement" at a faculty workshop at the University of Arizona College of Law.

**Professor Rob Fischman** participated in the Stanford University Workshop on Ecosystem Services and the Protection of Watersheds, Nov. 16-18. The interdisciplinary workshop included economists (including Nobel Laureate Kenneth Arrow) and ecologists (including Paul Ehrlich). Fischman's paper will be published in a symposium issue of the Stanford Environmental Law Journal.

**Ralph Gaebler's** review of "The Death Penalty: Abolition in Europe," appeared in 28 International Journal of Legal Information 558.

Associate Dean **Len Fromm** presented a lecture and workshop to the judges and lawyers of the Intellectual Property and International Trade Courts of Bangkok entitled "From Bangor, Maine, to Bangkok, Thailand: Problems on the Road to Pareto Optimal Settlements." He also taught a two week Negotiations Workshop to Lawyers in the LLM program at the law school at Chulalongkarn University.
