LAW SCHOOL GRANTS FOR WOMEN OF COLOR

This program offers a substantial amount of money to women of color enrolled in law school. In the past few years, four to six students have been selected each year and given awards ranging from \$5,000.00 to \$12,000.00. The American Association of University Women (AAUW) Educational Foundation is now accepting applications for its 2002-03 Selected Professions Fellowship in Law.

Description: These fellowships are awarded to women of color of outstanding academic ability who are citizens or permanent residents of the U.S. for full-time study in a JD program.

Eligibility: Fellowships are for the final year of the JD. The fellowship year is July 1, 2002 - June 30, 2003. Fellows must earn their degree at the end of the fellowship year.

Award Amount: \$5,000 - \$12,000. Award can be used for educational and living expenses

Deadline: Application must be postmarked by January 10, 2002
