

Austin V. Clifford Dies; Ex-I.U. Law Professor

Services for Austin V. Clifford, 78, R.R. 12, Bloomington, a retired attorney and Indiana University Law professor, will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday in the Day Mortuary at Bloomington. Burial will be in Crown Hill Cemetery. He died Saturday in his home.

He retired from I.U. in 1967 after 21 years. In 1967 he was given the Herman Frederick Liebert Award for excellency in teaching.

He had been practicing law at Bloomington since his retirement. Before joining the

I.U. faculty he practiced and lived here.

He was also a former member of the trust investment committee of the American Fletcher National Bank and Trust Company and was a former director of the Fletcher Trust Company.

He was graduated from Butler University and was a veteran of both World Wars.

Survivors include his widow, Mrs. Harriet R. Clifford; and a foster daughter, Mrs. Irene Armington of New York City.
