

Jerome Hall Gets Honor In Taiwan

Jerome Hall, Distinguished Professor of Law at Indiana University, has been awarded the honorary LL.D. degree by the China Academy in Taipei, Taiwan.

Hall, who is president of the American Society for Political and Legal Philosophy, is touring a number of Asian countries this summer as part of a lecture program sponsored by the U.S. Department of State.

In Taiwan, he is conferring with educators on the problems involved in building up that nation's law schools.

He also plans to attend a convention of the Law Asia Association, an organization consisting of legal experts and governmental leaders from Asian and Western Pacific nations, in Kaula Lumpur, Maylasia, July 1-4.

Professor Hall is a member of Asian Learned Societies, and honorary director of the Korean Legal Institute.

He also holds the honorary LL.D. degree from the University of North Dakota.
